As a general statement, case management means assessment of needs, planning activities and strategies to meet needs, implementing that plan through regular contact with the client and evaluating the effectiveness of the plan with the intent of making necessary changes. It includes knowledge of and linkage to community resources. All counselor positions must achieve and maintain certification.

Case Manager- (FULL-TIME) Intensive case management for homeless or at-risk for homelessness. Financial capability counseling and Housing placement. Requires extensive documentation and billing procedures. Full time position. Excellent writing skills, communication skills, and relationship building needed. Degree in Nursing, Counseling, Social Work, or Education preferred but experience may meet degree preference. Pay scale begins at \$17 an hour for uncertified trainees and will be set according to experience. Veteran preferred. Must be able to pass background check and subject to drug testing. Must have vehicle and be able to drive.
